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Welcome to Math 10 - NRF - Numbers Relations and Functions - with Mme Barton! This an elective course, meaning it is not required for High School Graduation. The course is, however, a pre-requisite to Foundations 11 and Pre-Calculus courses. We will focus on the pre-calculus skills needed as a foundation to perusing Calculus. There are numerous outcomes to cover and the course can prove challenging to some students. We will examine two major sections: 1) Algebra and Numbers (rational & irrational numbers, exponents, factoring, expanding) and 2) Relations and Functions (linear equations, slope, interpreting linear equations).

- Powers, Exponents and Roots
- Linear Relations, Functions & Equations
- Systems of Equations & Graphing
